

Ride for Less

Save up to 72% with a reduced fare if you qualify based on income.



How to Qualify

You must have a before-tax household income that is less than 200% of the federal poverty level. You must also be an Oregon resident age 18-64.

You automatically qualify if you participate in:

- Oregon Health Plan/Medicaid (OHP)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Energy Assistance (LIHEAP, OEAP, WAP)
- Free & Reduced Lunch
- HUD Assistance
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Employment Daycare (ERD)
- Women Infants and Children (WIC)

How to Apply

Be ready with proof of income (a benefit award letter, income documents, or current enrollment in an assistance program) and a government-issued photo ID.
