**SUBJECT: Letter of Approval for proposed fare code changes and updates**

At the November 22, 2020 Committee on Accessible Transportation (CAT) Business Meeting, Jamie Surface, Senior Coordinator, Fare Policy, and Greg Skillman, Senior Deputy General Counsel (Governance), presented the below to replace the TriMet Fare Code specific to LIFT fare code, Chapter 19.

*C. Door-to-door LIFT Services:*

*(1) The fare for door-to-door LIFT services, excluding rides paid for by agencies under contract with TriMet, shall be:*

*(a) Cash: \$2.50 per ride.*

*(b) Pre-paid LIFT Tickets: 10/\$25.00.*

*(c) Monthly LIFT Pass: \$74.00; non-transferable.*

*(d) Annual LIFT Pass: \$888.00; non-transferable.*

*(e) 20 trip LIFT punch card: \$48.00; valid for 20 trips on LIFT service only, non-expiring.*

*(f) A regularly scheduled service route transfer plus \$1.25.*

*(2) Purchase of a pre-paid ticket or pass does not guarantee that a ride will be provided.*

*(3) Only cash and LIFT specific fares are valid accepted on LIFT.*

*(4) eFare single use tickets are not valid fare on LIFT.*

*(5) A LIFT pre-paid ticket, LIFT monthly pass or LIFT annual pass is valid for travel on regular fixed route service when accompanied by valid TriMet Honored Citizen identification.*

The changes are cosmetic and corrective in nature and, there were no increases or changes to the existing and established fare amounts. Subsequent to this, the CAT Committee, with the required quorum of members, voted to approve the proposed changes and corrections at the CAT Business Meeting on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
